Do you need help preparing your taxes?

If so, the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program offers free tax preparation services to Vermonters making under \$42,000 per year. The program is a partnership between the IRS and the Chittenden County CASH Coalition, local United Way agencies and Community Action agencies.
